## The History of Fireworks

Gaze (1) up at the colorful lights of a fireworks display streaking across the sky can be an exciting end to a summer evening. Spectators clap and cheer as fiery flowers and waterfalls of sparks (2) light up the night sky. When towns or stadiums entertain outdoor crowds with fireworks displays, they are participating in a tradition that goes back thousands of years. Long before the United States existed, fireworks were already being used by people (3) to celebrate important occasions.

The first fireworks <u>would have been</u> (4) invented in China more than a thousand years ago. A mixture of charcoal, sulfur, and potassium nitrate was packed into paper cylinders or hollowed out bamboo sticks. A wick was <u>added it allowed</u> (5) the fireworks to be ignited safely. Once lit, the fireworks <u>soared</u> (6) into the sky to produce brilliant overhead displays. Because the sulfur gave the mixture a yellow color, these early fireworks were all yellow.

From China, fireworks came to Italy during the Renaissance. Rulers paid for firework displays as part of public celebrations to <u>commemorate</u> (7) their weddings or coronations. The Italians were the ones to begin adding different trace metals to the fireworks to <u>producing</u> (8) various bright colors. Each metal produced a different <u>effect copper</u> (9) salts made fireworks blue, barium salts made them green, and calcium made them orange.

By the 18th century, fireworks could have become common in Europe. (10) From there they came to the United States and were part of the <u>celebrate</u> (11) of America's independence in 1783. Since then, fireworks have been an American tradition. Many towns and cities put on an annual fireworks show that is eagerly awaited by town residents. Fireworks also add excitement to sporting events and help to end concerts on a <u>dramatic</u> (12) final note. <u>Today</u>, the fireworks accompanying some festivities or sporting events may be seen by television viewers all over the world (13).
