If they are constantly worried about being attacked by either their fellow citizens or foreign countries going to war against the U.S., living a secure and happy life is not possible. Cato seemed to think that this protection might not be effective in a country as big as the U.S., but the authors of the Constitution and the Federalists who argued for it did not share this concern.				
Cons gove Ame Righ	Because of objections like the one made by Mercy Otis Warren in Source 4, the Constitution protects citizens from actions taken by their own government. The government cannot, for example, take away private property or prevent any American from peacefully protesting. The protection of rights listed in the Bill of Rights promotes the general welfare by allowing citizens to live freely and securely because they can feel certain that their government's power over them is limited.
